

9. To minimise postage costs, it may be necessary to copy all entries onto another tape to send to the judges. The judges will be reminded that they are not viewing your original material. Material will be transferred digitally to mini DV tapes (to eliminate potential quality loss) for the public show.
10. **The judges' decision will be final.** The judges reserve the right to abandon viewing an entry after 15 minutes, at their discretion.
11. **The Public Show** will include as many videos and films as possible, but the organisers may have to show extracts and to choose those entries best suited to make a balanced programme which is acceptable to the expected audience. If extracts are shown, the maker will be contacted for approval.

Please note, if the film entered is NOT suitable for a general audience, the organisers reserve the right not to show it.
12. On any matters not covered by these rules, the Kent Film Festival committee's decisions will be final.

Awards—Winners will receive a small trophy which they will keep, plus a certificate.

These awards are for those who have not received any professional help.

Kent Film Festival Rules

1. **An amateur video** is deemed to be one that is made exclusively for the joy and challenge of making it, with no profit motive involved and without **paid** creative or other professional assistance other than processing, grading, the physical process of sound transfer or video copying. A student who has accepted **paid** creative help from a professional must enter the open class.
2. **Entrants** must be resident, or attending a college or school within Kent or an SE London postcode area or be a member of a Kent Club. Makers are encouraged also to enter the SERIAC Festival (the next step after the County Festivals) which is run by the IAC's South East Region.
3. **Special entrant categories:**
Juniors are below 17 years, **Students** 17—21 years, on the closing date of the entry. Junior, and Student entrants should declare what assistance they received.
Open entrants are those who have accepted paid professional assistance or are in higher education for a career in film/video making. They are not also eligible as Juniors or Students.
4. **Formats:**
The Festival accepts standard play videos on S-VHS or VHS with linear sound (i.e. that created by audio dub) **or** "HiFi" sound; Mini DV; Finalised DVD's as .VOB file. Other formats, including non-standard sound recording (i.e. MIX) can be considered at the sole discretion of the competition officer who may ask for assistance with equipment. Entries **must** be boxed to keep dust out, with title and entrants name on the cassette/sleeve or box. Please note, DVD-RW and DVD-RAM are not acceptable.
Only the first video on the tape submitted will be eligible, as entries will need to be viewed several times. Films, videos and DVD's must have not less than **10 seconds of black**, silent leader prior to any pictures or sound.
DVD's Only the film being entered into the Festival must be on the **DVD with a single start point and no menus**.
5. **Previous entries** to this competition will not be eligible unless they have been significantly worked on since then.
6. **Entering your movie:**
A completed and signed 2010 Entry Form (photocopies are acceptable) must accompany **each** movie. All competitors **must** provide cash or send a cheque made payable to the Kent Film Festival covering the **entry fee**. In all cases, the appropriate amount for return **postage** must be sent by those not collecting their entry from the Festival. All entries must be received by the Competition Officer by the **27th July, 2010**.
Kent Film Festival entry fees are : **£3.00 per entry** . Note, if a member of a club, you cannot use the club IAC number for your personal entries.
7. **Any copyright** in picture and sound must be cleared by the entrant who takes absolute responsibility for this. This includes any pictures or sound recorded from broadcast or professional video sources.
8. All entries will be handled with care, but competition organisers cannot accept liability for loss or damage, however caused.
